THOMAS J. CRAWFORD

CHRONOLOGY

- 2 September 1911 Born in Manning SC to Reverend James P. Crawford, a Presbyterian Minister and his wife Julia E. Godhold Crawford.
- 1925 Enrolled in the Academy of South Carolina State College.
- 1928 Graduated as valedictorian.
- 1932 Graduated from South Carolina, continuing on to earn a Masters of Science in Chemistry.
- 1934 Earned Masters degree in Chemistry from Cornell University.
- 1935 Began teaching at South Carolina College as an instructor.
- 1936-1959 Associate Professor, Chemistry, South Carolina State College.
- 1941 Married Marian Maxine Sulton.
- 1960-1969 Director of Student Activities and Public Relations, South Carolina State College.
- 1966 Crawford introduced “sound” at home football games And was the “voice of the Bulldogs” in Dawson Bulldog Stadium for 30 years.
- 1968-1975 Director of Admissions and Records, South Carolina State College.
- 1969 Membership in Alpha Iota Chapter of Fraternity’s Sixth District.
- 1978 Received the Distinguished Service Award in recognition of outstanding professional achievement in education and science to humanity.
- 1981 Elected Commissioner to the 193rd General Assembly of the United Presbyterian Church (USA).

- 1981 Chosen Grand Marshall of the Homecoming Parade at South Carolina State College and again in 1995.
- 1984 A facility was built in his honor and named the Thomas J. Crawford-Dudley M. Zimmerman Complex.
- 14 Feb. 1995 Marian Maxine Sulton Crawford died.
- 20 July 1996 Died.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Thomas J. Crawford was born September 2, 1911. He attended Mayesville Educational and Industrial Institute and Presbyterian Parochial School in Manning, SC. He graduated as Valedictorian from the Academy in 1928, and in 1932 he graduated from South Carolina State College. He received his Masters of Science in chemistry from Cornell University. While at South Carolina State College, Crawford served in the following positions: Associate Professor of Chemistry and Biology, Director of Student Activities, Director of Public Relations, Placement Office, Sports Information, and Admissions and Records. He introduced “sound” at home football games and was the “Voice of the Bulldogs” in Dawson Bulldog Stadium for 30 years.

In 1984 a facility was built in his honor and named Thomas J. Crawford-Dudley M. Zimmerman Services Complex. He was named President of Alpha Kappa Mu National Honor Society in 1970. He was chosen Grand Marshall of the Homecoming Parade at South Carolina State College in the fall of 1981 and again in 1995 and was inducted into the First South Carolina State College Athletic Hall of Fame in the fall of 1983. He was twice named “Omega Man of the Year” by Epsilon Omega chapter of fraternity’s Sixth District. He was also elected to membership in Alpha Iota Chapter of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, Inc. in 1969 and remained an active member until 1996. Crawford was also a member of the Edisto Federal Credit Union for over forty years, serving as chairman of its credit committee.

Crawford was a life member of the NAACP, and worked with several other community and civic programs, while receiving numerous awards and honors for his contributions. Crawford served as an Elder in St. Luke Presbyterian Church (USA), and was a member of the chancel choir. He served on numerous committees and programs at the church. At Charleston-Atlantic Presbytery, he was a member of the Capital Funds Committee; he was an at large member of its council. Crawford was a former member of its nominating committee and was elected Commissioner to the 193rd General Assembly of the United Presbyterian Church (USA) in 1981. In 1978, Crawford received the Distinguished Service Award in recognition of outstanding professional achievement in education and science to humanity.

For fifty years Crawford worked with programs of Boy Scouts of America and was presented the Silver Beaver Award for Distinguished Service to Youth by the Central South Carolina Council.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Thomas J. Crawford collection consists of 13 cubic feet of materials, including 9.5 cubic feet of photographs. The photographs, newsclippings, and other items span the years of 1919-1996. The Thomas J. Crawford Collection reflects campus life, the events of the Orangeburg Massacre, and the many changes at South Carolina State University throughout its history.

Series I: Athletics

Series I consists of 2.5 cubic feet of photographs depicting spectator sports dating from as early as 1919. The series is organized into eight sub-series: football, basketball, bowling, golf, track and field, volleyball, tennis and wrestling.

Series II: Activities/Events

Series II consists of 2.5 cubic feet of photographs depicting various campus activities and events, including homecoming, Founders' Day, fraternity and sorority activities, parades, the Marching 101 band, and classroom activities. Campus visitors are also depicted, including Benjamin Mays, Barbara Bush, Al Gore, Jayne Kennedy, and Senator Matthews.

Series III: Presidents/Trustee

Series III consists of 1 cubic foot of photographs depicting University Presidents from Dr. Benner C. Turner to current President Dr. Leroy Davis doing the business of the University on a daily basis. Also included are images of graduations, retirements, banquets, special events, roasts, athletic suppers, memorials, the President's house during the annual Christmas drop-in, and Board members.

Series IV: Buildings

Series IV consists of .5 cubic feet of photographs depicting the buildings that make up the South Carolina State University campus, including Lowman Hall and Dukes Gym, which are both on the National Register of Historic Places because of their design. Images also detail the renovations to the Oliver Dawson Football Stadium and aerial views of the complete campus.

Series V: People

Series V consists of .75 cubic feet of photographs depicting individuals with connections to the University over the years. The majority of the images depict students, faculty and staff, and the community.

Series VI: Miscellaneous

Series VI consists of .75 cubic feet of photographs that could not be positively identified. Many depict football players that did not have names attached to the photos and unidentified groups.

Series VII: Proofs-Negatives-Slides

Series VII consists of 1.5 cubic feet of proofs, negatives, and slides from the photos in the collection.

Series VIII: Papers

Series VIII consists of six sub-series: Orangeburg Massacre, Pan-Hellenic Council, Newsclippings, Obituaries, Photographs, and Miscellaneous. The Orangeburg Massacre sub-series includes letters written to Lt. Gov. John West from South Carolina State College Students expressing their grievances regarding the Orangeburg Massacre. The sub-series also contains some of West's replies and hospital records of students that needed medical care as a result of the Massacre. The Pan-Hellenic Council sub-series contains reports and background information on the council and its members. The Newsclippings sub-series contains information about students, faculty, staff, the local community, and local churches. The Obituaries sub-series contains obituaries of South Carolina State University students, faculty, and staff and community members. The small number of photographs contained in the Photographs sub-series depict faculty, staff, and community members. The miscellaneous sub-series consists of unidentified photographs, Crawford's student chemistry notebooks, and South Carolina State University memorabilia. Also contained in this sub-series is information on local churches and the Sulton family.
